





# Dual Enrollment

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1. Dual Enrollment is an agreement between the Bradford County School System and Santa Fe College. It allows high school students a chance to earn both high school and college credits while they are in high school at no cost to the student.
2. Incoming ninth graders will be allowed to take the College Placement Test(CPT) after review of their first nine weeks report card at BHS. You must have a 3.0 in order to take the CPT and in order to continue in the dual enrollment program. If you have a 2.5 to a 2.9 GPA, you are eligible to take the College Success Course following passing scores on the PERT and teacher recommendation.
3. Students may now take advantage of dual enrollment opportunities at the Bradford-Union Technical Center!

# AP Courses

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- ◆ You can earn college credit, if you pass the AP exam with a 3 or higher
- ◆ The AP courses earn weighted credits toward your GPA.
- ◆ All students enrolled in an AP Course will be expected to take the AP exam.
