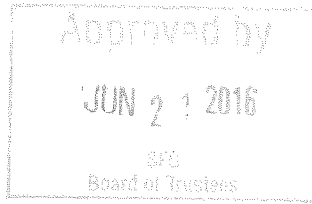

Second Amendment to Bradford County High School Dual Enrollment
Articulation Agreement

408.2263, 15-16

The proposed second amendment to the 2013 articulation agreement with Bradford County adds a Dual Enrollment option for students in Bradford County not meeting current program eligibility. This amendment will allow certain students to take the class known as "College Success." This amendment will be effective August 1, 2016.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO DUAL ENROLLMENT ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
(School Board of Bradford County and Santa Fe College)

This Second Amendment to the Dual Enrollment Articulation Agreement by and between the School Board of Bradford County, Florida and The District Board of Trustees of Santa Fe College, Florida effective August 15, 2013 (hereinafter the "Agreement"), as amended by the First Amendment to Dual Enrollment Articulation Agreement effective August 25, 2014 (hereinafter the "First Amendment"), is hereby entered into and shall be effective as of August 1, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties hereby agree to further amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The definition of Academic Dual Enrollment in Article II of the Agreement is hereby modified by adding the following to the end of the section: Notwithstanding the foregoing requirements, secondary students may qualify to take one course, SLS1101, with a 2.5 cumulative unweighted GPA calculated based upon at least 3 full high school credits, college-level scores on the PERT, SAT, or ACT in at least one area, a recommendation from a school faculty member, and a demonstration of the maturity needed to ensure success in a college class.
2. The Agreement and the First Amendment are hereby modified by replacing all references to "FCAT 2.0" with "10th Grade FSA ELA."
3. The second paragraph of numbered Clause 4 under Guidance and Counseling Services in Article II (see page 5 of 17 of the Agreement) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Accommodations for disabilities can be arranged through the College's Disability Resource Center (DRC) in accordance with the laws governing students with disabilities at postsecondary institutions.

The remainder of this page is intentionally left blank.

4. To the extent of any conflict between the terms of the Agreement as modified by the First Amendment and the Second Amendment, this Second Amendment shall govern the rights of the parties hereto. All terms and conditions of the Agreement and the First Amendment not expressly modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.
